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CODE OF CONDUCT

It is a privilege to have the opportunity to serve our great God by being a volunteer in mission. The primary purpose of a volunteer is to radiate the love of Jesus Christ as we help repair lives through repairing, constructing, and cleaning up homes and their surrounding property.

Asbury's goal is for every volunteer to have a safe and productive Project experience; therefore, it is imperative to commit full attention to each responsibility and task assigned. Every volunteer has a responsibility to keep a Project site safe for themselves and others.

I understand that participating as a volunteer on Mission Columbus Projects requires me to be flexible, adaptable, sensitive, patient, and safety conscious. I will abide by the following conduct requirements and **I have marked each box to indicate I have read and fully understand each requirement:**

- No use or possession of alcohol, drugs, tobacco or illegal substances.
- I will not be under the influence of any alcohol, drug or other substance when I arrive at a Project other than a prescription drug prescribed by a physician for me or an over the counter medicine. If I have taken any prescription drug or over the counter medication that can affect my alertness or ability to handle equipment or tools, I will advise an Asbury volunteer supervisor prior to starting any work. The supervisor will make the final determination whether I can participate in a Project.
- No horseplay, bullying, intimidation, inappropriate touching or foul language.
- Appropriate attire is required and is subject to approval by the volunteer supervisor.
- Follow directions given by volunteer supervisors.
- Cell phone usage for youth participants shall be limited while working. Focus shall be on the work.
- If driving a vehicle is needed for a purpose associated with a Project, no cell phone usage (voice or text) while driving is allowed.
- Treat all volunteers, participants and residents with respect and courtesy.
- Respect all property at the Project including all tools and equipment used for a Project.
- Participate as directed in Project chores, responsibilities and duties. I will NOT do more work than detailed or instructed to. I understand the homeowner has authorized certain work to be done and I will not exceed that authorization without known permission or consent from the homeowner.

**I UNDERSTAND AND ACKNOWLEDGE THAT AT ALL TIMES DURING A PROJECT I AM REPRESENTING,
AND MY CONDUCT IS A REFLECTION OF, ASBURY, MY FAMILY, AND GOD.**
